MTTC Prior to Student Teaching Varies by Program	March 15	September 15
Music Education (MED) Teaching Candidates must have passing scores for the MTTC in Music Education on file with OCE in order to be eligible for MED student teaching.		
Special Education (SED) Teaching Candidates are eligible for student teaching in their SED internship when they fulfill the criteria stated below:		
<ol> <li>A passing grade in all elementary and special education coursework with one exception, SED 5130 (3 credits), which can be taken during student teaching without requesting a policy waiver from the SED program. <i>OR</i> Pass the MTTC in their SED specialization area.</li> <li>SED student teachers who wish to enroll full time (12 credits) during student teaching may enroll in 9 credits of student teaching and 3 credits of SED 5130. No other enrollment option is allowed without a waiver by the Special Education faculty. Waivers can be made by the Special Education faculty on a case-by-case basis.</li> <li>Maintain an undergraduate grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or graduate (MAT) GPA of 3.0.</li> </ol>		
Teaching candidates in programs other than MED and SED do not need to submit MTTC scores prior to student teaching; MTTC may be taken during student teaching.		
All teaching candidates must have passing scores for the MTTC on-file with COE before recommendation to Michigan Department of Education for certification. Candidates are strongly advised to discuss plans to register for and take the MTTC with their Academic Advisors and Program Coordinators.
